Supply Chain Assessment Process & Policy

Arnts the Landscape Supplier will review its supply chains annually to identify, assess and monitor high-risk engagements with third parties. This assessment is also to be done for any potential suppliers we are considering importing goods from. Once a list of suppliers is gathered, the steps are as follows:

- Ensure all suppliers have been sent our <u>Expectations of Suppliers</u> document to review;
- Plot Suppliers on the <u>global slavery index map</u> to determine if any of our supply chains are at risk:
- If a supplier operates in a mid-high risk area, survey the supplier regarding their
 policies and due diligence processes in relation to forced and child labour. We
 will conduct this survey via our Modern Slavery Act Letter;
- If the supplier's answer to our Modern Slavery Act Letter indicates a risk of forced or child labour we will develop a plan to manage that risk and assess our effectiveness in ensuring that forced and child labour aren't being used in our supply chains.
